She informed that the University is conducting all the activities of the Academic Year 2022-23 as per the University's Academic Calendar. The End Semester Examinations of 2<sup>nd</sup> year to 4<sup>th</sup> Year of all programs have been completed, and Mid Semester Exams of all the students of the First Year have also been conducted smoothly. She also informed that the admission process of all UG, PG and Ph.D. programs is in progress for the Academic Year 2023-24.



The visibility of IGDTUW and its perception among the general masses has grown by leaps and bounds. She was elated to apprise the following achievements of the University after the conduct of the 17<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Finance Committee held on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2023:

❖ **World's Universities with Real Impact (WURI) Ranking (International Ranking):**

The cash award amounting Rs. 23.85 Lakh, along with a Certificate of merit, was given to faculty and students in recognition of their excellent contribution towards the Good Quality Research Publications and Grant of Patents in various disciplines of the University.

The Research Awards were given to Forty-Eight (48) faculty members and Sixty (60) students for the research publications for 2021-2022, while three (03) faculty members and four (04) students were awarded the grant of the patent for the year 2022.

❖ **Placement Status for the Academic Year 2022-23**

The placement drive for the session 2022-23 commenced in August 2022. 918 students have received returning offers/placement in top Tech companies like Google, Microsoft, Goldman Sachs, Adobe, American Express, Amazon, Uber, Intuit, Atlassian, and many others. The highest CTC offer received is ₹ 82 Lakhs by Atlassian. In addition, 58 students have received a package of ₹40 Lakhs and above. The average salary received by the students for the pre-placement offers so far is ₹20.60 Lakhs CTC. The placement drive of UG and PG programs is still ongoing for 2022-23.
