



# **Eligibility and Admission Procedure**

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

A woman candidate who has scored at least 50% marks in 12<sup>th</sup> board examination from a recognised board and must also have passed English (Core/Elective/Functional) as a subject in the 12<sup>th</sup> Board Examination. Those who are appearing in the examination may also apply, provided that they submit the proof of eligibility by a specific date declared by the University.

#### Admission Criteria

The merit list shall be drawn on the basis of marks in **best of four subjects** (**including English**) in XII Board examination or its equivalent examination. Vocational courses (as specified in the CBSE list) will not be counted in the best four subjects.

To resolve and determine inter se merit of candidates having same percentage in the best of four subjects (including English), following criterion will be used in the stated order of preference:

- 1. Candidates having higher score in English (core/elective/functional) will be given preference.
- 2. In case the score in English is same, then date of birth will be considered. Elder candidate will be given preference.

**NOTE**: Candidates who have appeared at the Annual Examination in the year 2022 and have been placed in compartment will not be eligible for admission for the year 2022.

# **Age Criteria**

For BBA Program in IGDTUW, maximum age should not be more than 40 years on 30.09.2022.

# Relaxation in Minimum Marks Criterion in Qualifying Examination for Reserved Category/Sub-Category Candidates

Candidates belonging to various reserved categories namely OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, and sub-categories namely Defence, Person with Disability, who apply for seats reserved for them, shall be allowed a relaxation in the minimum marks criterion as mentioned below:

(i) Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL): Candidates claiming reservation under Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) category shall be

- allowed a relaxation of 5% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- (ii) **Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST):** Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST) shall be allowed a relaxation of 10% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- (iii) **Defence (CW):** Candidates claiming reservation under Defence subcategory (CW) shall be allowed a relaxation of 5% marks in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.
- (iv)**Persons with Disabilities (PwD):** Candidates claiming reservation under "Persons with Disabilities" (PwD) sub-category shall be allowed a relaxation of 10% marks.

#### Intake

# **Reservation Policy**

#### **Delhi Region**

Delhi Region Candidates (85% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located within the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Delhi Region only.

#### **Outside Delhi**

Outside Delhi Region Candidates (15% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located outside the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Outside Delhi Region only.

**NOTE:** For a candidate, who has passed the qualifying examination through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School, Delhi (NIOS), the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of her centre of examination. In other words, if the centre of examination is located in the N.C.T. of Delhi, the candidate shall be considered under the Delhi Region and if the centre of examination is located outside N.C.T. of Delhi, she shall be considered under the Outside Delhi Region.

- **a) Scheduled Caste (SC):** 15 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates.
- **b) Scheduled Tribe (ST):** 7.5 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates.
- c) Other Backward Class (OBC- NCL): 27% of the total seats are reserved for Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates.
- **d) Economically Weaker Section (EWS):** 10% of the total seats are reserved for EWS category as per the office order DHE.1 (119)/Estt. /2018- 19/2549-76 dated 17/06/2019

Sub-categories namely 'Defence' and 'Person with Disability' are available under each category (General, SC, ST, OBC-NCL).

- **e) Defence (CW):** 5% of the total seats (Horizontal) in each main category are reserved for candidates belonging to Defence sub-category in the following order of priority:
- **Priority I** Widows/wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.
- **Priority II** Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service.

**Priority III** - Widows/wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.

**Priority IV** - Wards of disabled in service and boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service.

**Priority V** - Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel/para military/police personnel who are in receipt of the following Gallantry Awards: 1. Param Vir Chakra 2. Ashok Chakra 3. Mahavir Chakra 4. Kirti Chakra 5. Vir Chakra 6. Shaurya Chakra 7. Sena/Nau Sena/ Vayu Sena Medal 8. Mention-in-Despatches 9. President's Police Medal for Gallantry 10. Police Medal for Gallantry

**Priority VI** – Wards of Ex-servicemen.

#### **Priority VII** – Wives of:

- 1. Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service
- 2. Defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service
- 3. Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry awards.

**Priority VIII** – Wards of serving personnel.

**Priority IX -** Wives of serving personnel.

- **f) Person with Disability:** 5% of the total seats (Horizontally) in each category are reserved for candidates belonging to 'Person with Disability' sub-category in accordance with the provisions of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016' (PwD Act).
- **g) Kashmiri Migrants (Supernumerary):** 01 (One) seat, over and above the total intake is available under this category. First preference will be given to Kashmiri Migrant candidate:
  - (i) who has passed the qualifying examination from a school/college/ institute located within the NCT of Delhi;
  - (ii) whose parents are registered in Delhi up to 11.06.2001 as Kashmiri Migrant; and
  - (iii) who is residing in the N.C.T. of Delhi.
- h) **Business Blasters (Supernumerary):** 15 (Fifteen) seats, over and above the total intake is available under this category. For Eligibility criteria and admission process please visit https://sangam.nsut.ac.in/adm/cmac/

#### Note:

- i. In case of category (a) and (b), the vacant seats are interchangeable.
- ii. In case, sufficient numbers of eligible candidates from category (c) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved.
- iii. Seats under sub-category (f) are interchangeable within the sub category if sufficient number of candidates is not available in a particular group.
- iv. In case, sufficient number of eligible candidates from the sub categories mentioned at (e) and (f) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved in the respective category.
- v. Under CW sub-category, the seats will be filled based on the priority, i.e., all eligible candidates of priority-I will be allotted seats based on their ranks until the ranks exhaust or seats exhaust under CW sub category. Remaining vacant seats, if any, will be allotted to the priority-II in the similar way, and so on.
- vi. The reservation under CW sub category is available only to such candidates who fall under the listed priorities.
- vii. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories/sub categories. 
