Societies, Memberships and Social Initiatives

IGDTUW believes in holistic development of students and shows acute concern in inculcating social responsibilities. In line with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, IGDTUW has adopted five villages to spread digital literacy, health and sanitation awareness, etc. Since last year University is working

for Vigyan Jyoti Project of DST with the mandate to promote and create awareness on STEM Education among the girl students. This Project has fetched an over-whelming response from Government Schools where students of Class 10th came for training during summer breaks and walked out confidently with a self-made working robot.

IGDTUW Incubation Centre – “Anveshan Foundation – TBI”

Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women (IGDTUW) has incorporated and promoted '**IGDTUW Anveshan Foundation**' a Section 8 Company under the Companies Act, 2013 to propagate entrepreneurial culture and ecosystem specially among women, on 13th October 2016. Government of NCT of Delhi has funded INR Two crores Fourteen Lakhs in three tranches to support Anveshan Foundation i.e., for Innovation, Entrepreneurship, Start-ups and Incubation related activities at the University Campus.

Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India has sanctioned INR Four Crore Fifty Lakhs to accelerate the activities of Anveshan Foundation. Now, Anveshan is a **Technical Business Incubator (TBI)** under 'National Initiative for Development and Harnessing Innovations (NIDHI)' scheme of DST. First tranche of Rs. One Crore fifty-four lakhs has been received in the month of July 2021.

Facilities

All kind of facilities (pertaining to the start-up ecosystem), which are expected from a state of art incubator in India, are available at Anveshan Foundation. In the complete 'incubation and venture development cycle', Anveshan is helping entrepreneurs and start-ups in i) Pre-incubation, ii) Incubation, iii) Acceleration, iv) Post-incubation and even v) Virtual Incubation.

CISCO has established complete IoT and robotics Lab 'thingQbator' (worth INR 60 Lakhs) for Innovation through its CSR funds in the year 2018 through its partner organization NASSCOM Foundation in support with Defy and Li2. thingQbator has conducted four cohorts giving benefits to more than 300 students of the University.

GiZ India (a German organization) had signed a Contract with Anveshan Foundation worth INR 27.5 Lakhs for Strengthening Incubation & Start-up Ecosystem specially for Women Entrepreneurs. Under this contract twenty-two mentorship sessions, three workshops, three boot camps, four incubators meets and two Pitch/demo days were organized. This initiative and support from GiZ India have benefited more than five thousand participants all over the country.

Anveshan Foundation is conducting regular internships, pragmatic workshops and short-term courses on a) Start-up Management, b) Entrepreneurship Management, c) Innovation & Entrepreneurship, d) Digital Marketing, e) Python, f) Family Business & Entrepreneurship, g) Entrepreneurship and Venture Development and in many more technical/ non-technical areas for confidence building among aspiring entrepreneurs specially women.

Total seventeen private limited companies are working as start-up 'Incubatees' with Anveshan Foundation. All of these incubatees are women enterprises. Details of all these Incubatees along with their products & services are available on the website of Anveshan Foundation.

Incubation Center provides facilities for Company Incorporation, fully furnished air-conditioned office space, complete ICT and free consultancies in technical, business and strategic front to all of its Incubatees. There is also a provision of Seed Fund against equity for 'Incubatees with Investment'.

IGDTUW Anveshan Foundation has a pool of consultants and mentors associated with it to augment the businesses of its Incubatees, which is an essential part of the Acceleration Phase. Support in Product Development, Product Refinement, Marketing, Human Resources, Supply Chain, Franchise Models and Bargaining with Investors are provided by Anveshan Foundation.

Incubation Center has also signed ten MoUs with other colleges, institutes and universities to facilitate and establish incubation centers in their premises and to accelerate and diversify businesses of their students and Incubatees through various channels.

After the incubation period, at the phase of post-incubation hand holding support continues from Anveshan Foundation in consultancy, laboratories, innovation support and portfolio management. Through virtual mode, Anveshan Foundation is helping many other start-ups all over the country.

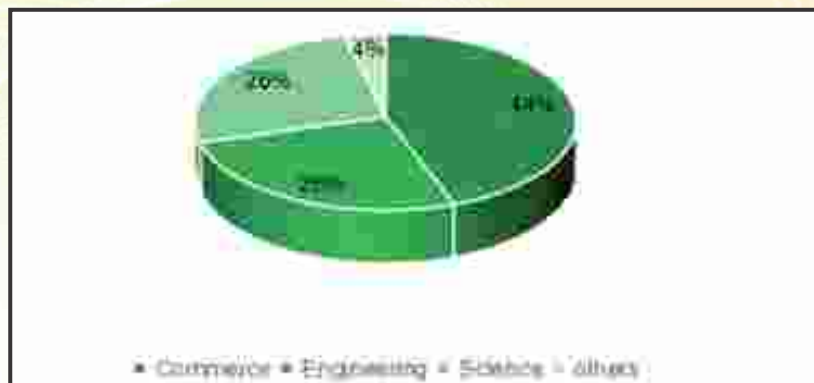
Internships and Placements for MBA students

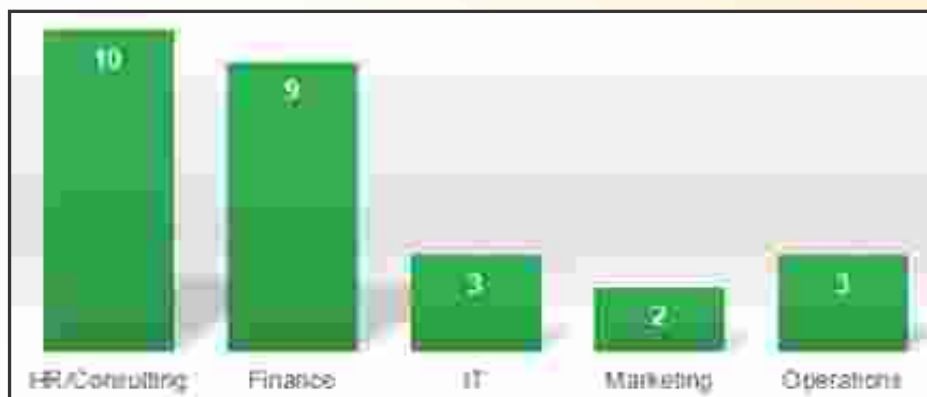

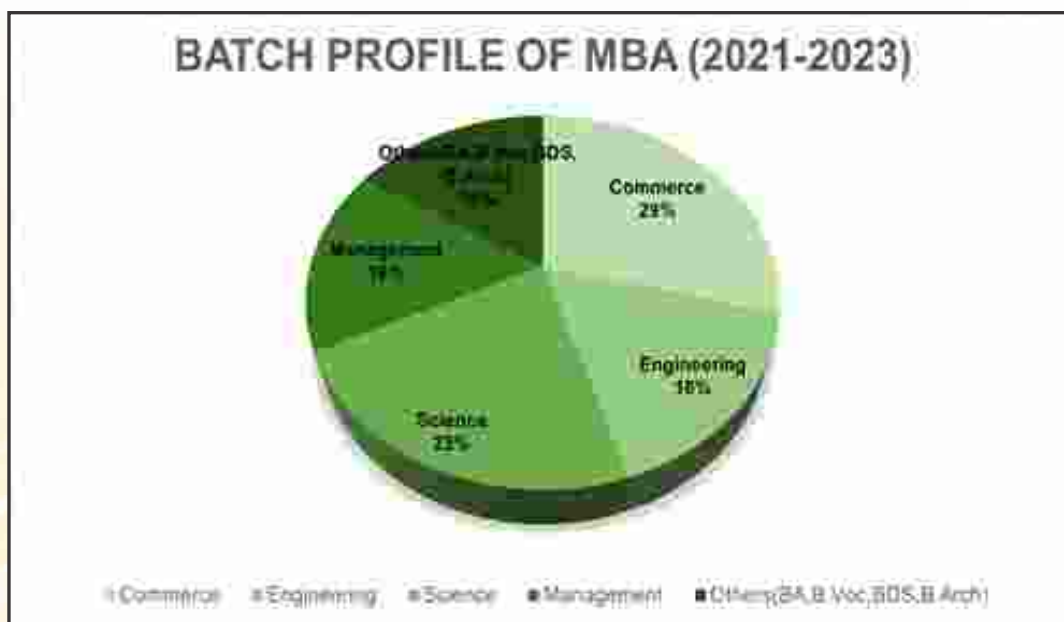
BATCH PROFILE OF MBA (2020-2022)

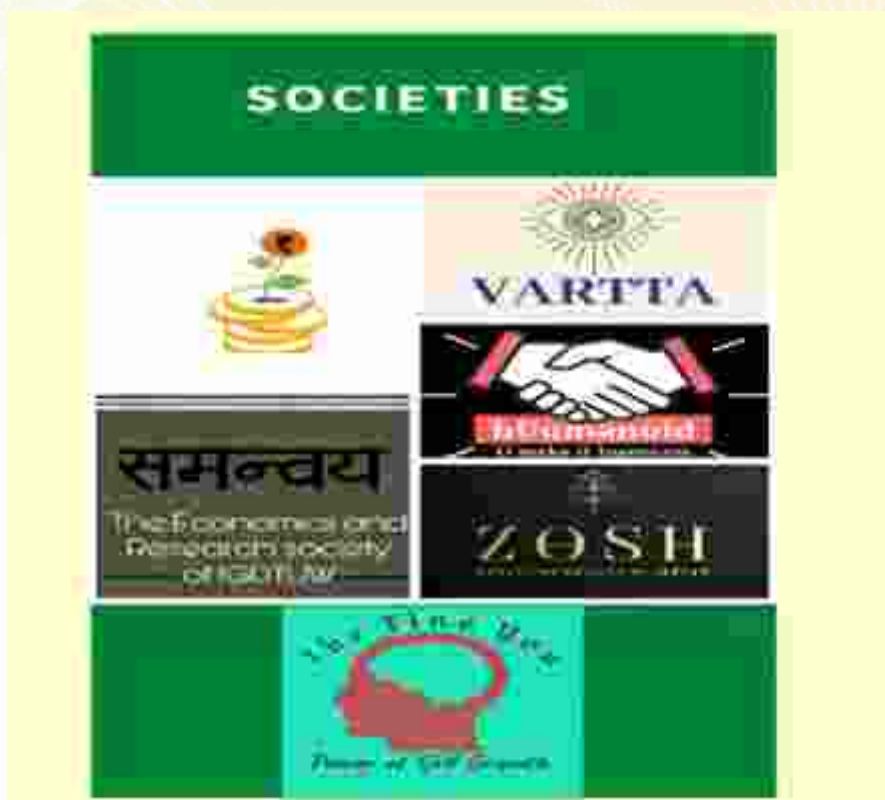

(i) Security Deposit (Refundable): - Rs. 5,000/-

(ii) One Time Alumni Fee: - Rs. 2,000/-

Hostel and Mess fee, if applicable, will be paid separately.

Eligibility and Admission Procedure

Eligibility Criteria

a) A female candidate who has passed any Bachelor Degree examination with minimum 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA from a recognised university/institution and valid CAT-2021 /MAT-2021 /MAT-2022 percentile

OR

A female candidate who has passed any Bachelor Degree examination with minimum 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA from a recognised university/institution and has minimum one year of work experience

However, a relaxation of 10% in marks to SC/ST/PWD candidates and 5% to Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL) / Defence Category (CW) shall be given in minimum eligibility criteria.

b) The student should hold a degree from any of the universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India, or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a university under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

c) Those who are appearing in final semester examination may also apply, provided that they submit

(i) The proof of eligibility by a specific date declared by the University, and

(ii) Valid CAT/MAT percentile at the time of application,

otherwise the admission of the candidate to the university will be cancelled.

Candidates appearing in final semester/year should have at least 60% aggregate marks till the last result declared at the time of submission of application.

In case the conversion formula for CGPA is not provided by the concerned Institute/ University, equivalent percentage shall be computed as per following formula:

CGPA × 10 = Percentage of Marks

Note: At any stage of the program, if it is found that the candidate does not fulfil the eligibility criteria, her admission shall be cancelled and fee shall not be refunded.

Intake

The annual intake of this program is 75. The reservation of the seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS and sub categories Defence/PwD are as per the norms. One seat is for Kashmiri Migrant over and above the total intake. However, there will be no relaxation in the minimum eligibility criteria for Kashmiri Migrant.

* One seat is for Kashmiri Migrant over and above the total intake. However, there will be no relaxation in the minimum eligibility criteria for Kashmiri Migrant.

Reservation Policy

a) Scheduled Caste (SC): 15 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates.

b) Scheduled Tribe (ST): 7.5 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates.

c) Other Backward Class (OBC- NCL): 27% of the total seats are reserved for Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates.

d) Economically Weaker Section (EWS): 10% of the total seats are reserved for EWS category as per the office order DHE.1 (119)/Estt. /2018- 19/2549-76 dated 17/06/2019

Sub-categories namely 'Defence' and 'Person with Disability' are available under each category (General, SC, ST, OBC-NCL).

e) Defence (CW): 5% of the total seats (Horizontal) in each main category are reserved for candidates belonging to Defence sub-category in the following order of priority:

Priority I - Widows/wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.

Priority II – Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service.

Priority III - Widows/wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service.

Priority IV - Wards of disabled in service and boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service.

Priority V - Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel/para military/police personnel who are in receipt of the following Gallantry Awards: 1. Param Vir Chakra 2. Ashok Chakra 3. Mahavir Chakra 4. Kirti Chakra 5. Vir Chakra 6. Shaurya Chakra 7. Sena/Nau Sena/ Vayu Sena Medal 8. Mention-in-Despatches 9. President's Police Medal for Gallantry 10. Police Medal for Gallantry

Priority VI – Wards of Ex-servicemen.

Priority VII – Wives of:

1. Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service
2. Defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service
3. Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry awards.

Priority VIII – Wards of serving personnel.

Priority IX - Wives of serving personnel.

f) Person with Disability: 5% of the total seats (Horizontally) in each category are reserved for candidates belonging to 'Person with Disability' sub-category in accordance with the provisions of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016' (PwD Act)

g) Kashmiri Migrants (Supernumerary): 01 (One) seat, over and above the total intake is available under this category.

Note:

- i. In case of category (a) and (b), the vacant seats are interchangeable.
- ii. In case, sufficient numbers of eligible candidates from category (c) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved.
- iii. Seats under sub-category (f) are interchangeable within the sub category if sufficient number of candidates is not available in a particular group.
- iv. In case, sufficient number of eligible candidates from the sub categories mentioned at (e) and (f) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved in the respective category.
- v. Under CW sub-category, the seats will be filled based on the priority, i.e. all eligible candidates of priority-I will be allotted seats based on their ranks until the ranks exhaust or seats exhaust under CW sub category. Remaining vacant seats, if any, will be allotted to the priority-II in the similar way, and so on.
- vi. The reservation under CW sub category is available only to such candidates who fall under the listed priorities.
- vii. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories/subcategories. The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS/KM categories, CW/PwD sub-categories will be required to upload scanned copy of the respective certificates and produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub- category issued by the competent authority (as mentioned in this information brochure) in the respective institutes at the time of physical verification of the documents. If the reserved category/ sub-category certificate is not found in order, no benefit of the reserved category/ sub-category will be given and the candidate shall be considered for allotment in GENERAL category in subsequent rounds on submission of written request by the candidate to CMAC in person or email in this regard, as per the eligibility of the candidate and availability of seats. **If such candidate is able to produce her category certificate before the commencement of further round, she shall be considered for the category in that round and will be allotted a fresh seat as per the vacancy available and her merit.**
- viii. After exhausting the complete list of registered SC, ST, OBC and EWS candidates, the vacant seats will be treated as unreserved in the "SPOT ROUND"

Selection Procedure

1. All the applications received will be shortlisted on the basis of performance in CAT-2021/MAT-2021/MAT-2022 / Graduation percentage with one year experience.
2. The shortlisted candidates are required to appear for a Personal Interview and/or Group Discussion.
3. Admission shall be made on the basis of final merit list prepared on the basis of CAT-2021 / MAT-2021/ MAT-2022 percentile/ Graduation percentage with one year experience and performance in Personal Interview and/or Group Discussion.
4. The final merit will be generated by giving 80% weightage to CAT/MAT percentile/ Graduation

percentage with one year experience and 20% weightage to Group Discussion and Personal Interview.

5. The preference will be given to the candidates in the following order-
 - I. Candidate with valid CAT percentile
 - ii. Candidate with valid MAT percentile
 - iii. Candidates graduated with at least 60% with one year work experience.
6. CAT percentile (rounded up to two decimal places) of 2021 will be considered whereas best percentile of MAT-2021/ MAT-2022 will be considered.
7. Allotment of University will be done on the basis of rank of the candidate in the merit list and 'preference of the University' applied by the candidate.
8. CMAC may decide an appropriate cut-off percentile of CAT/MAT/Graduation percentage with one year experience to prepare respective merit lists of the students for the purpose of short listing the candidates for admission.
9. In case of tie in the final merit list, the following criteria shall be used:
 - a) The candidate with higher CAT percentile shall be ranked higher.
 - b) In case of tie in CAT percentile, the candidate with higher MAT percentile shall be ranked higher (in case of candidates with both CAT and MAT percentile)
 - c) In case of tie in CAT/MAT percentile, higher work experience will be ranked higher.
 - d) In case of tie in work experience, candidate with higher aggregate marks in graduation will be ranked higher.
 - e) In case of tie in graduation marks, the candidate shall be ranked according to the date of birth i.e., the person higher in date of birth will be ranked higher.

Note: The University may invite fresh applications against vacant seats, if any, by following an alternative admission criterion as decided by the CMAC.

Registration Process

All candidates desirous of seeking admission to the MBA programs at IGDTUW (common form for DTU and NSUT) are required to visit website www.igdtuw.ac.in and fill registration form on the provided CMAC link there, pay a non-refundable registration fee and fill the choices for allotment of seat. The details of registration fee are given below:

NOTE: ONLINE REGISTRATION IS ALLOWED AS PER COUNSELING SCHEDULE ONLY.

- i) The candidate will initially authenticate herself by entering personal details and will choose the password for subsequent logins. After successful registration, an application number will be generated by the system and provided to the candidate.
- ii) Candidate will login by using system generated application number and password to complete the remaining activities to complete CMAC application form in steps.
- iii) Candidate will use the Application Number and chosen password during registration for subsequent logins. After successful login, candidate will be redirected to the home page to complete the remaining activities like Application form submission, upload images and documents, choice filling, registration fee payment etc.
- iv) Candidate must ensure that the BANK ACCOUNT details filled by her at registration must be valid and should BELONG TO THE CANDIDATE OR HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBERS. This bank account will be used to refund academic fee/spot round fee if required by CMAC Delhi.
- v) On completion of application form, candidate needs to upload all relevant documents as per her category/sub-category. This will include her scanned copy of photograph, class X mark sheet, XII-mark sheet, Graduation certificate/mark sheet, Category certificate (if any for EWS/OBC/SC/ST), sub-category certificates, CAT-2021/MAT-2021/ MAT-2022 percentile and work experience details if any. Before final submission, candidate will review the filled data and can edit again before final submission.
- vi) Once application form is complete in all respect and all the required documents have been uploaded, candidates needs to confirm her registration form. The candidate is not permitted to edit/change details filled in the registration form once the candidate confirms the final submission. If candidate leaves the form incomplete, she can continue filling application form through CMAC Delhi portal login.
- vii) Once application form is complete and confirmed by the candidate, she will have to pay a non-refundable registration fee. Candidates are required to make a payment through configured payment gateway.
- viii) Candidate has to take the printout of the registration form signed by Guardian / Parents and Self, which has to be submitted at the time of admission/reporting in the institute.

Note:

- i) **After successful registration and fee payment, candidates are required to visit the website www.igdtuw.ac.in again and fill choices for universities on the provided link.**

- ii) After completing the application form successfully if candidate does not pay the registration fee of Rs. 1000/-, she will not be considered for any seat allotment in any round of the counseling. (No refund of registration fee for such candidates will be applicable)
- iii) In case the candidate fails to submit category certificates. The admission of such candidates may be considered with changed credentials (e.g., if OBC certificate is not valid/submitted, category may be changed from OBC to GENERAL as per the category conversion rule).

Certificates Required for Reserved Seats at the Time of Document Verification

The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS categories, CW/PwD subcategories will be required to produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority at the time of document verification.

Persons with Disabilities (PD) sub-category

For admission to seat reserved for Differently Abled Person (PwD) sub-category, the candidate must produce the following certificates in original at the time of document verification for PwD candidates.

1. A certificate of physical disability issued by the Competent Authority as per the provision of the Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 in the prescribed format as given under the Act.
2. The Candidate with benchmark disabilities shall produce the medical certificate issued by the Govt. Hospitals duly notified by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi/Other State government and further duly verified by the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned Government Hospital.
3. A certificate duly recommended by Vocational Rehabilitation Centre for the handicapped, 9-11 Vikas Marg, Karkardooma, Delhi 110092.

Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST) /Other Backward Class (OB)

For admission to a seat reserved for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class - Non Creamy Layer (OBC - NCL), candidates must produce a certificate, in original, issued from an approved district authority stating the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/ Other Backward Class (NCL), to which the candidate belongs.

A list of approved authorities is given below:

- a. District Magistrate / Additional Magistrate / Deputy Commissioner / Collector / Additional Deputy Commissioner / Deputy Collector / 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate / City (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate), Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- b. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- c. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidates and/or his/her family normally resides.
- d. Administrator/Secretary to Administration/Development Officer (Laccadive & Minicoy Islands).

NOTE :

1. The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories has to mandatorily produce the caste/category certificate in his/her name at the time of counselling. The certificate in the name of either of the parents (mother/father) or any other family member is not acceptable and the candidate will not be entitled even for provisional admission.
2. OBC (NCL) candidates are required to produce a caste certificate issued after March 31, 2022 from the authorities as mentioned above. However, if the caste certificate is issued prior to March 31, 2022, it must be accompanied with an additional NCL certificate regarding the present non-creamy layer status of the candidate, issued by the same competent authority. This additional NCL certificate must have reference of his / her already issued original caste certificate.
3. In case of the most recent OBC (NCL) certificate is not available as per point 2, undertaking regarding the same is to be submitted with the available certificate (format of the undertaking is available on the website).

Economically Weaker Section: Criteria for Income and Assets

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed by persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority based upon the following criteria:

- Candidates whose family has gross annual income below Rs 8.0 lakh (Rupees eight lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.
- Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-
 - i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
 - ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
 - iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
 - iv. Residential, plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority after March 31, 2022. The Income and Asset Certificate issued 'by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in Annexures shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as 'belonging to EWS.

A list of approved authorities is given below:

- (i) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/ Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/ 1st Class Stipendary Magistrate/ SubDivisionalMagistrate/ Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner
- (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate
- (iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and
- (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or her family normally resides.

Defence sub-category (CW)

For admission to a seat reserved for Defence sub-category, candidate must produce the following certificates (as applicable), in original, at the time of document verification of Defence candidates.

- (a) Entitlement card in original issued by the Record Officer of the Unit/Regiment of Armed Personnel of the Armed Forces in case of Armed Personnel.
- (b) Widows/ Wards/ Wives of the officers and men of Armed forces who died or were disabled on duty (both attributable to military service) must produce a certificate to that effect from the following authorities:
 - (i) Secretary, Kendriya Sainik Board.
 - (ii) Secretary, Rajya / Zila Sainik Board.
 - (iii) Officer-in-Charge, Record Office.
- (c) Medical records in original.
- (d) Special Pension Order and Passbook indicating special pension.
- (e) Gallantry Award Certificate.
- (f) Original ex-servicemen Identity Card/Discharge Book/ Pension Payment Order.
- (g) Dependency card issued by the competent authority in order to relate the relationship of the candidate with the Defence personnel.
- (h) Original Service Identity Card.
- (i) A certificate from the respective C.O. Unit in respect of serving personnel.

NOTE:

A statement to the effect that 'the death/disability is attributed to military service' is required to be included in the certificate for Priority III & IV.

Kashmiri Migrants:

The candidates seeking admission under Kashmiri Migrants seats must upload the following documents at the time of filling up of the online application.

Admission Process

Payment of Seat Acceptance Fee

All the candidates who get an allotment will have to pay part admission fee (Rs.1,00,000 – Rupees One Lakh through demand draft) as per the admission schedule, failing which her allotted seat will stand automatically cancelled and the candidate will not be considered for subsequent rounds of seat allotment. However, such candidates are eligible for spot round of counselling. Balance fees need to be paid by the candidate in the respective University by the date declared by CMAC.
