## Summer Internships and Placements

59 top and well-reputed companies like Google, Microsoft, MotorQ, Uber, Urban Company, Atlassian, Expedia, ServiceNow, Intuit, Flipkart, and many more have offered pre-placements, full-time, six months internships, summer internships and dual offers to the students of batch 2023-24. Till the end of October 2023, a total of 774 offers have already been received. The University is thrilled with accepting about 168 pre-placement offers, i.e. the returning offers from top Tech companies like Google, Microsoft, Goldman Sachs, Adobe, American Express, Amazon, Uber, Intuit, Atlassian, and many others.

It is for the very first time, i.e., an enormous number of students were placed before the commencement of the placement drive. 290 full-time offers and 110 six months internship (including dual offers) offers have been grabbed by the students. The University is expecting more prominent offers like these in the coming years. About 31 students have already secured offers of 51 lakh from Microsoft after their internship. Apart from the above, 41 students were offered summer internships at Microsoft. Google has offered a CTC of 30 lakh to 10 students, extended summer internship offers to 2 students. 3 students have been given the golden opportunity to work in Uber with a CTC of 38 lakh, and 2 students have been offered pre-placement internship offers along with 1 summer internship offer. 8 students have been extended full-time offers from Goldman Sachs with a CTC of 24 lakh, and 7 students were offered 2-month internships.

Amazon has offered 8 pre-placement offer to our final-year students with a CTC of 52.89 lakh. Intuit has offered a dual offer of 6 month + Full time to 3 students along with 1 pre-placement offer to students in their final year with a CTC of 44.4 lakh and summer internship offers to 3 pre-final year students. Service now has extended pre-placement offers to 2 students with 42.6 lakh, along with side offering summer internships to 8 of our pre-final year students. Atlassian offered the pre-placement offer to 1 student along with full-time role to 2 final-year students with a CTC of 34 lakhs and summer internship offers to 2 pre-final year students. ARQ has offered full time to 2 students of final year with a CTC 31 lakh and summer internship to 1 student of pre-final year. Expedia has offered 2 pre-placement offer to final year students with a CTC of 27 Lakh. Flipkart has offered 1 pre-placement offers along with 4 dual offers of 6 months + full time with a CTC of 32.5 lakh and pre-placement internship to 1 of our pre-final year student. Morgan Stanley has offered 6 pre-placement offers along with 3 dual offers of 6 months + full time with a CTC of 29.48 lakh and summer internship to 5 of our pre-final year students. Wells Fargo has offered 7 pre-placement offers along with 15 full time offers with a CTC of 24 lakh and summer internship to 20 of our pre-final year students.

Currently, 57 B. Tech (MAE) final-year students have full time offers from reputed firms. Proud to mention, 21 students have bagged 6-month internship offers from tech giants like Amazon, Flipkart, American Express, etc. This year has seen a notable increase in the number of new companies compared to prior years. The highest CTC

50 LPA was offered by Adobe and the average CTC was 14.35 LPA for the graduating batch of 2023. The MAE Training and Placement Cell keeps organizing industry engagement activities and contests on a regular basis to help students keep current with industry trends and learn critical technical skills needed to become effective engineers in their disciplines. With continued visits from firms that are still in the recruiting process, we anticipate that 100% of students will be placed by the conclusion of the placement session. It is a matter of tremendous pride to share that in comparison to that last year 2021-22, there has been a rise in average CTC from Rs. 8.73 Lakhs per annum to Rs. 14.35 Lakhs per annum. There has also been a rise from 38 FTE offers in 2021-22 to 57 FTE offers in 2022- 23. In addition to that, 21 final year students were selected for the 6-month internship at some top-notch companies.

The MAE Training and Placement Cell helps the students by regularly organizing industry interaction activities and competitions to stay abreast of current industrial trends and gain key technical skills to become proficient engineers in their fields. Leading in every domain, Mechanical girls have once again proved their excellence, bagged opportunities and giving notable results. One final year student was part of the Cisco women in cyber security boost campaign 2.0. Team Yantriki participated in Aravali Terrain Vehicle Championship virtual season 2 and were AIR 1 overall winner, AIR 1 in CAE, Cost Report, DFMEA Report. 3 students were selected for Pratibha - The Eaton Excellence Award in the year 2022.15 pre-final year students were selected as a mentee in the Microsoft engage program throughout the country, while one pre-final year student was selected for the Harvard WeCode Scholarship. One student was among the top finalists of the Amex Makeathon and received an intern offer at American Express. Students participated in Scholarship and hackathons like GHC Scholar for the year 2022, Smart India Hackathon, millennium fellowship program.



## Eligibility and Admission Procedure

### Educational Qualification and Eligibility Conditions for Admission

The candidate seeking admission in B. Tech. (Lateral Entry) in 2<sup>nd</sup> year shall possess the essential qualification as per Table 1

### Selection Criterion

- **For 50% weightage:** Marks obtained in regular diploma in any branch of Engineering and Technology with a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate from any State Board of Technical Education/Diploma recognised by AICTE.
- **For 50% weightage:** Personal Interaction/Interview/CUET Score.

### Relaxation in Minimum Marks

Relaxation of 5% marks for candidates claiming reservation under OBC-NCL/ Defence sub-category (CW) and 10% for SC/ST/PwD sub category in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.

## Reservation Policy

### Delhi Region

Delhi Region Candidates (85% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located within the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Delhi Region only.

### Outside Delhi

Outside Delhi Region Candidates (15% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located outside the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Outside Delhi Region only.

**NOTE:** For a candidate, who has passed the qualifying examination through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School, Delhi (NIOS), the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of her centre of examination. In other words, if the centre of examination is located in the N.C.T. of Delhi, the candidate shall be considered under the Delhi Region and if the centre of examination is located outside N.C.T. of Delhi, she shall be considered under the Outside Delhi Region.

**a) Scheduled Caste (SC):** 15 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates.

**b) Scheduled Tribe (ST):** 7.5 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates.

**c) Other Backward Class (OBC- NCL):** 27% of the total seats are reserved for Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates.

**d) Economically Weaker Section (EWS):** 10% of the total seats are reserved for EWS category as per the office order DHE.1 (119)/Estt. /2018- 19/2549-76 dated 17/06/2019

**Note:**

i. In case of category (a) and (b), the vacant seats are interchangeable.

ii. In case, sufficient numbers of eligible candidates from category (c) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved.

iii. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories. The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS categories will be required to upload scanned copy of the respective certificates and produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority (as mentioned in this information brochure) in the respective institutes at the time of physical verification of the documents. If the reserved category certificate is not found in order, no benefit of the reserved category will be given and the candidate shall be considered for allotment in GENERAL category.

iv) After exhausting the complete list of registered SC, ST, OBC and EWS candidates, an equivalent number of unreserved seats shall be created against the vacant reserved category seats in the "SPOT ROUND".

#### **Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL):**

For admission to a seat reserved for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), candidate must produce a certificate, in original, issued from an approved district authority stating the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), to which the candidate belongs. A list of approved authorities is given below:

- b. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- c. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidates and/or his/her family normally resides.
- d. Administrator/Secretary to Administration/Development Officer (Laccadive &Minicoy Islands).

NOTE:

1. The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories has to mandatorily upload the caste/ category certificate in his/her name at the time of filling up of the ONLINE form. The certificate in the name of either of the parents (mother/father) or any other family member is not acceptable and the candidate will not be entitled even for provisional admission.
2. 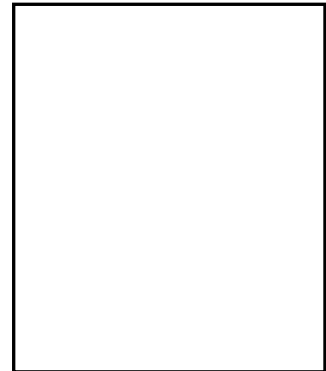

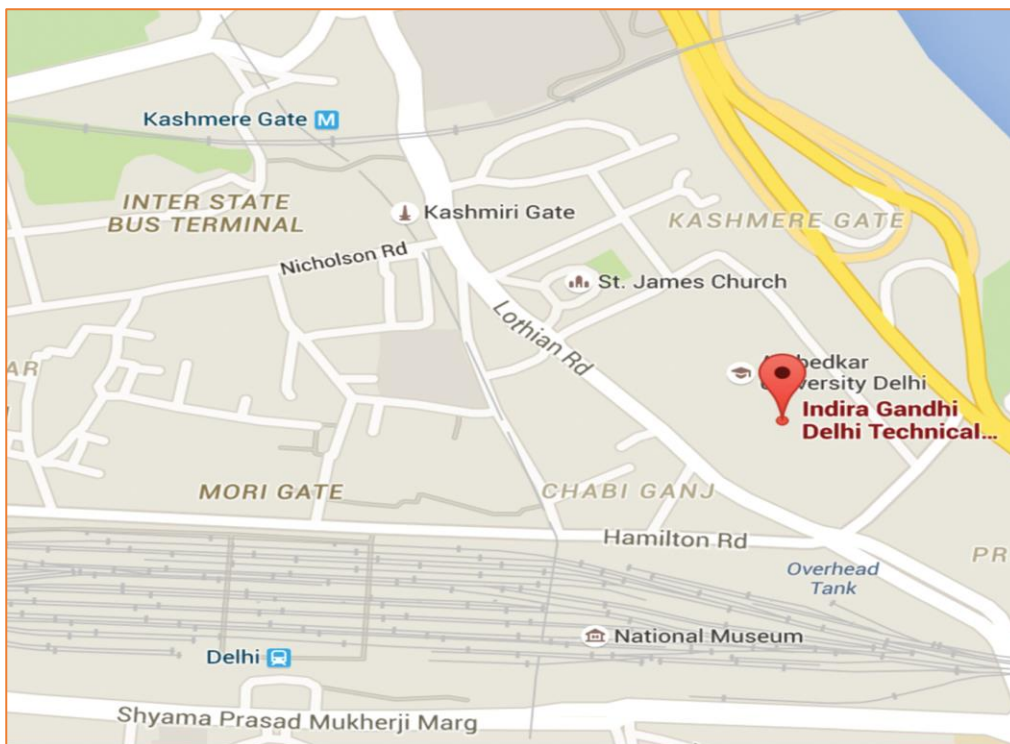
